Introduction

The Erie Metropolitan Transit Authority provides paratransit services for eligible individuals under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA).

Eligibility

Applications are available at the Erie Metropolitan Transit Authority's offices at 127 East 14th Street, Erie, PA 16503 or by calling the ADA Administration at 814-459-4287. Applications are also available at the e/LIFT office at 825 West 18th Street Erie, PA 16502 814-455-3330.

Applications must be completed and returned to the ADA Administrator. You will be notified upon approval.

If you are denied eligibility or your eligibility is suspended or restricted, you have the right to appeal. Appeal instructions are provided in the denial notification.

Response Time And Reservations

Eligible ADA individuals are required to make reservations one (1) day prior to traveling by calling the LIFT at 814-456-2299. On Holidays that The E does not operate service, reservations may be left on the answering machine at 814-455-3330 extension 229.

Service Area

The service area consists of corridors with width of 3/4 mile on each side of each fixed bus route and 3/4 mile radius at the ends of each fixed bus route.

Fares

The fare is \$2.20 cash for a one-way trip in the Erie urbanized area. The fare for service beyond the urbanized bus routes is \$2.20 per zone based on the fixed bus route zones. Cost will be confirmed when you schedule.

If you require a personal care attendant (escort) to accompany you on your ride, he/she rides free. You must specify, when scheduling your trip, that an escort will be accompanying you.

There is a provision for having a guest accompany you on a trip. The fare is the same for your guest as what you pay.

Days And Hours Of Service

Service is provided within the service area during the same hours and on the same days as the regular bus routes.

Currently urbanized bus routes operate Monday through Saturday from 5:30 a.m. to 11 p.m. and on Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Route 11 (Harborcreek) operates on Wednesday and Friday. Route 12(Albion) operates on Monday and Thursday. Route 13 (Corry) operates on Friday. Route 14 (Edinboro) operates Monday through Saturday. Mercyhurst North East operates Monday through Friday while school is in session.

the e does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. There is limited LIFT service on Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

The service area, days and hours are subject to change with modifications in "the e's" fixed route bus system.
